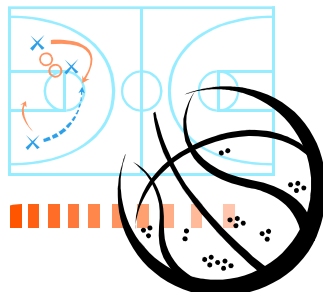

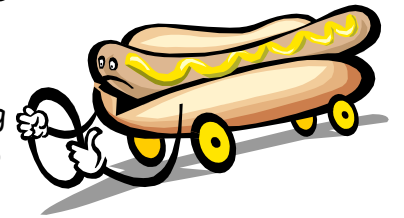
### Almost Perfect Guess!
