All bills are in and paid and we have a final total for this year's auction. After expenses, DCS netted \$82,098.90! From that figure, \$14,325.50 will be set aside for the student financial aid fund leaving \$67,773.40 for classroom enhancements and start-up for next year's auction.

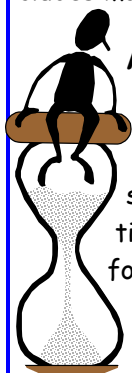

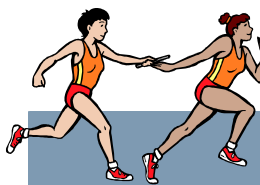
